Have you ever wondered why EOPO hands out certificates for your participation in professional development and on committees? It is because all NAEOP members are eligible to participate in the Professional Standards Program (PSP) which recognizes people for their work experience, education and in-service credits, and participation in associations. At the minimum, you need the following:

- Four years of work experience, two must be in an educational institution or educational affiliated institution
- Education and in-service training measured either in clock hours or by degrees; if you have 210 hours, you can apply no college courses required
- Association responsibility or participation points which are based on professional memberships, committee participation, and leadership roles

Check out the PSP program information on the NAEOP website: https://www.naeop.org/programs. Your forms need to be signed by the State PSP Chair before they are submitted to the National Office. 
